The principles behind GDPR-style regimes, and the rights they create.

General principles; specific obligations vary by jurisdiction.

Principle	Means
Lawfulness, fairness, transparency	Have a basis and say what you do
Purpose limitation	Collected for a stated purpose
Data minimisation	Only what is necessary
Accuracy	Kept correct and up to date
Storage limitation	Not kept longer than needed
Integrity and confidentiality	Kept secure
Accountability	Able to demonstrate compliance

Educational reference. The six lawful bases include contract, legal obligation and legitimate interests — consent is often the weakest
