Lower risk

Drafting varied practice questions to check

Rewriting a text at a different reading level

Generating distractors you then verify

Producing first-draft feedback you edit

Summarising your own documents

Higher risk

Unchecked factual content for pupils

Marking that affects a reported grade

Anything involving pupil personal data

Detection of AI-written work: unreliable

Subject explanations outside your expertise
