Law

Expanded state power in a crisis, and the safeguards on it.

## Typical powers

Restrictions on movement and assembly

Requisition of property

Expedited rule-making

Detention powers in some systems

## Safeguards

Time limits with renewal votes

Sunset clauses ending the powers

Continued judicial review

Parliamentary scrutiny and reporting

Non-derogable rights remain protected

Educational reference. The recurring concern is normalisation: emergency powers persisting after the emergency has passed.
