80	quatre-vingts	four-twenties
81	quatre-vingt-un	four-twenties-one
90	quatre-vingt-dix	four-twenties-ten
99	quatre-vingt-dix-neuf	four-twenties-nineteen

Belgium and Switzerland use septante and nonante for 70 and 90 — far more logical, and not used in France.
