

Adjective Endings

Languages

The endings that follow from case, gender and which article precedes.

After a definite article (weak endings). Nominative and accusative.

Case	M / F	N / Pl
Nominative	-e / -e	-e / -en
Accusative	-en / -e	-e / -en
Dative	-en / -en	-en / -en
Genitive	-en / -en	-en / -en

After der/die/das, most endings are -en. Only five slots take -e, all in the nominative and accusative.
