The w-words, and the case some of them change with.

Wer changes with case, like a pronoun.

Word	Means	Note
wer	who	wen (acc), wem (dat), wessen (gen)
was	what	wen/was for things
wo	where	position
wohin	where to	movement
woher	where from	origin
wann	when	
warum / wieso	why	
wie	how	wie viel – how much

German splits English 'where' three ways: wo, wohin and woher.
Choosing wrong is immediately noticeable.
