

Relative Clauses

Languages

The relative pronouns, and the word order they force.

Relative pronouns look like definite articles, with two exceptions.

Case	M / F	N / Pl
Nominative	der / die	das / die
Accusative	den / die	das / die
Dative	dem / der	dem / denen
Genitive	dessen / deren	dessen / deren

Gender comes from the noun outside; case comes from the role inside.
Der Mann, den ich sehe — masculine, accusative.
