

Knowing the Coins

1st Grade

Telling the coins apart by size, colour and edge, before any counting.

Recognise the coin first. Counting money is impossible until you can name them.

Coin	Worth	How to spot it
Penny	1c	the only copper-coloured one
Nickel	5c	thick, smooth edge, bigger than a dime
Dime	10c	the smallest coin of all, ridged edge
Quarter	25c	the biggest of the four, ridged edge

The dime is worth more than the nickel but is smaller. Size does not tell you value.
