

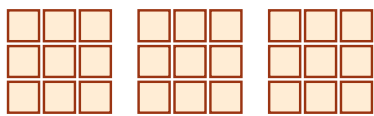
Place Value to Hundreds

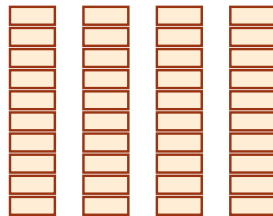


3 hundreds = 300

4

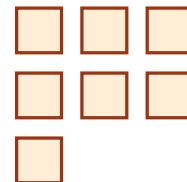


4 tens = 40

each block = 10

ONES

7



7 ones = 7

each block = 1

THE SAME NUMBER, THREE WAYS

Standard

347

Expanded

300 + 40 + 7

Words

three hundred forty-seven

THE BIG IDEA

A digit's worth depends on where it sits. In 347 the 3 is not three — it is three hundred.

Ten of any place makes one of the next place along:

ten ones = one ten · ten tens = one hundred · ten hundreds = one thousand
