READ IT OUT LOUD

482,915

"four hundred eighty-two thousand,
nine hundred fifteen"

Read each period, then say its name. The comma is where you say "thousand".

EXPANDED FORM

$400,000 + 80,000 + 2,000 + 900 + 10 + 5$

Each place is ten times the place on its right, and a tenth of the place on its left.
A zero holds a place open: 405 is four hundreds, no tens, five ones.

COMPARING

Line the numbers up on the right, then compare from the left — first difference wins.
