3rd Grade

Which ten, which hundred — and the only digit you need to look at.

Rounding is not a trick. It is asking which landmark number is closer.

FIND THE PLACE

1

Rounding to the nearest ten? Underline the tens digit.

LOOK ONE TO THE RIGHT

2

That single digit decides everything. Ignore the rest.

5 OR MORE, ROUND UP

3

4 or less, leave the digit as it is.

ZERO THE REST

4

Everything to the right of your place becomes zero.

WORKED

47 → nearest ten: 7 is 5 or more → 50

342 → nearest hundred: 4 is less than 5 → 300

365 → nearest hundred: 6 → 400

Exactly halfway (like 45) rounds up by convention. Everyone agrees, so answers match.
