

# Dividing by 10

4th Grade

Every  $\div 10$  fact, with the multiplication that proves each one.

*Every digit moves one place to the right. It ends in 0.*

| Division                        | =  | Check it             |
|---------------------------------|----|----------------------|
| <b>10 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 1  | $1 \times 10 = 10$   |
| <b>20 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 2  | $2 \times 10 = 20$   |
| <b>30 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 3  | $3 \times 10 = 30$   |
| <b>40 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 4  | $4 \times 10 = 40$   |
| <b>50 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 5  | $5 \times 10 = 50$   |
| <b>60 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 6  | $6 \times 10 = 60$   |
| <b>70 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 7  | $7 \times 10 = 70$   |
| <b>80 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 8  | $8 \times 10 = 80$   |
| <b>90 <math>\div</math> 10</b>  | 9  | $9 \times 10 = 90$   |
| <b>100 <math>\div</math> 10</b> | 10 | $10 \times 10 = 100$ |

Divisibility test for 10: It ends in 0.
