

Dividing by 5

4th Grade

Every $\div 5$ fact, with the multiplication that proves each one.

Divide by 10, then double the answer. It ends in 0 or 5.

Division	=	Check it
5 $\div$ 5	1	$1 \times 5 = 5$
10 $\div$ 5	2	$2 \times 5 = 10$
15 $\div$ 5	3	$3 \times 5 = 15$
20 $\div$ 5	4	$4 \times 5 = 20$
25 $\div$ 5	5	$5 \times 5 = 25$
30 $\div$ 5	6	$6 \times 5 = 30$
35 $\div$ 5	7	$7 \times 5 = 35$
40 $\div$ 5	8	$8 \times 5 = 40$
45 $\div$ 5	9	$9 \times 5 = 45$
50 $\div$ 5	10	$10 \times 5 = 50$

Divisibility test for 5: It ends in 0 or 5.
