

Dividing by 8

4th Grade

Every $\div 8$ fact, with the multiplication that proves each one.

Halve, halve, halve. Halve it three times and land on a whole number.

Division	=	Check it
$8 \div 8$	1	$1 \times 8 = 8$
$16 \div 8$	2	$2 \times 8 = 16$
$24 \div 8$	3	$3 \times 8 = 24$
$32 \div 8$	4	$4 \times 8 = 32$
$40 \div 8$	5	$5 \times 8 = 40$
$48 \div 8$	6	$6 \times 8 = 48$
$56 \div 8$	7	$7 \times 8 = 56$
$64 \div 8$	8	$8 \times 8 = 64$
$72 \div 8$	9	$9 \times 8 = 72$
$80 \div 8$	10	$10 \times 8 = 80$

Divisibility test for 8: Halve it three times and land on a whole number.
