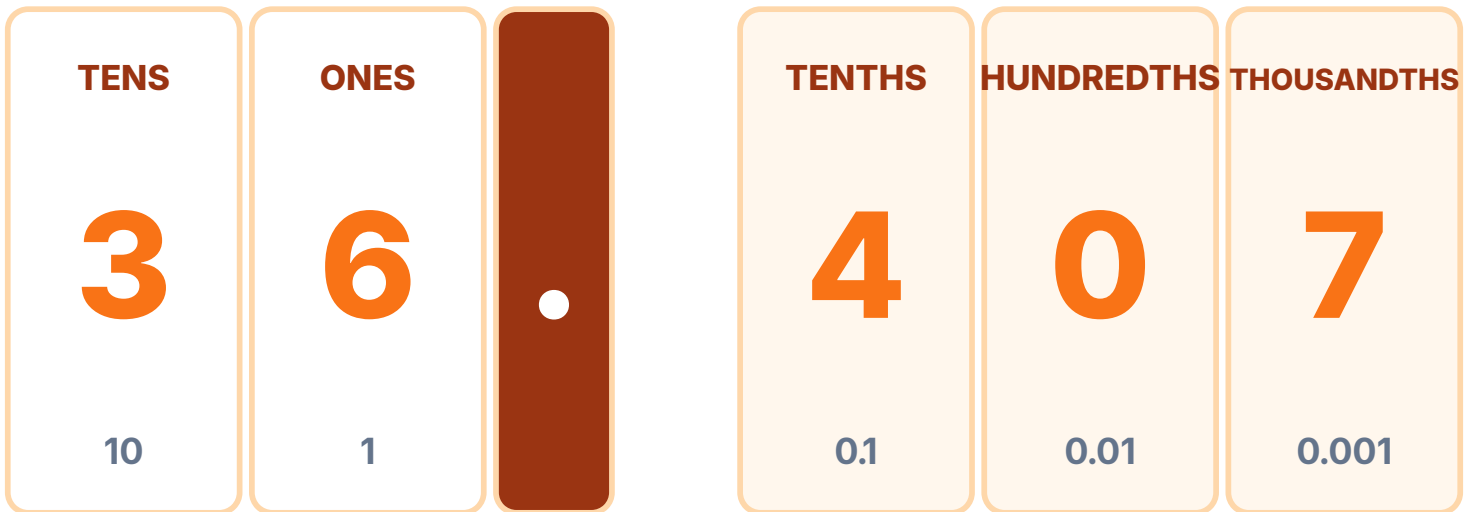


Decimals & Rounding

5th Grade

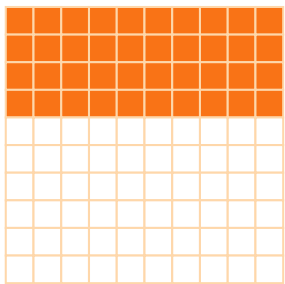
Place value to thousandths, plus a rounding rule on a number line.



SEE IT



$0.4 = \text{four tenths} = 4/10$

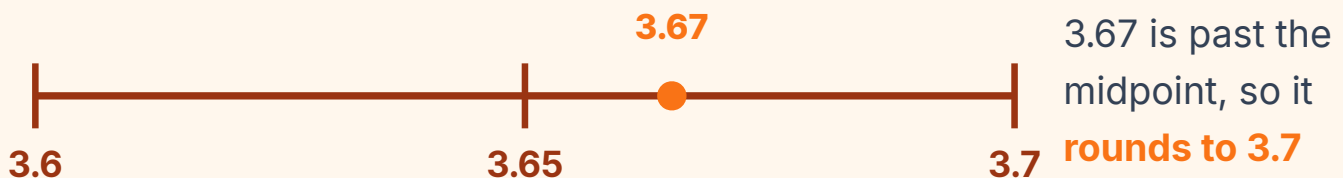


$0.40 = 0.4$ — extra zeros never change the value

0.407 is 407 thousandths — read all three places.

Line up the decimal points before adding or comparing.

ROUNDING — which one is it nearer?



RULE

Look at the digit to the right. 5 or more rounds up; 4 or less leaves it alone.
