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MAIN PARTS

nose, trachea

- You breathe about 20,000 times a day.
- The diaphragm pulls down to draw air in.
- Alveoli are tiny air sacs where the gas swap happens.
- There are around 300 million alveoli in a pair of lungs.
- Breathing out removes carbon dioxide, which is a waste product.
