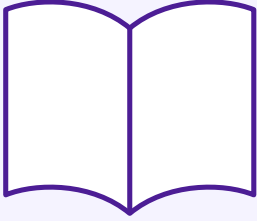

Descriptive language that appeals directly to the five senses.

- Example: warm bread, crackling crust
- Example: the sharp bite of winter air
- Example: sticky, sweet and cold
- How to spot it: Ask which sense the description is aimed at.
- Effect: Lets the reader experience the scene rather than be told about it.

LOOK FOR IT

Ask which sense the description is aimed at.

Naming it earns half the mark. Explaining its effect on the reader earns the other half.
