The codes you actually meet, grouped by who is at fault.

2xx worked · 3xx go elsewhere · 4xx the caller erred · 5xx the server erred.

Code	Name	Means
200	OK	It worked
201	Created	It worked and made something
204	No Content	It worked, nothing to return
301	Moved Permanently	Update your link
304	Not Modified	Use your cached copy
400	Bad Request	The request is malformed
401	Unauthorized	You are not logged in
403	Forbidden	Logged in, still not allowed
404	Not Found	No such thing
429	Too Many Requests	Slow down
500	Internal Server Error	The server broke
502	Bad Gateway	An upstream server broke

401 means unauthenticated and 403 means unauthorised. The names have been backwards since 1997.
