Theory and its principle.

Theory	Just distribution is one that
Utilitarian	Maximises total welfare
Rawlsian	Benefits the least advantaged most
Libertarian	Arises from just acquisition and transfer
Egalitarian	Equalises a specified currency
Capability	Secures real freedoms to function

Educational reference. Rawls's veil of ignorance asks what rules you would choose not knowing your own position.
