Weber's three dimensions of stratification, and why one does not reduce to another.

Three orders that overlap but move independently.

Dimension	Resource	Example of mismatch
Class	Market position	Rich, socially excluded
Status	Honour, lifestyle	Poor cleric, high regard
Party	Organised power	Small union, real leverage

Status groups practise closure: credentials, dress codes and taste guard entry as effectively as price does.
